

HELP FOR HAITI DRIVE

On the evening of January 12, 2010, a major 7.0 magnitude earthquake hit Haiti. It is the most powerful quake to hit the struggling country in more than 200 years. The tremor struck 15 km (10 miles) southwest of the capitol of Port-au-Prince, and was quickly followed by two strong aftershocks of 5.9 and 5.5 magnitude. According to reports, as much as 70% of buildings and homes have been compromised or destroyed, with debris continuing to fill the streets making rescue and relief efforts slow and difficult. However, despite the fear, uncertainty and the enormous challenges that lay ahead, the outpouring of support from the U.S. and around the world has been amazing!

On January 25th-29th, the ABC Group will be hosting a Help for Haiti Drive to collect basic necessities for the victims of this devastating quake. Collections boxes will be stationed by the main office. Below is a list of supplies that we are collecting during the drive:

Water Dried food items such as rice and beans Canned goods Clothes- <u>Summer Only</u> Shoes Kitchen Items Shampoo, soap, toilet paper... <u>all hygiene products</u> All medical supplies (<u>this is direly needed right now!</u>) School Supplies Towels Bedding Toys Following our drive, the items will be given to the Marilyn W. Dugan Foundation, a charitable organization based in Wilton who is sponsoring a shipping container that will be sent to Haiti at the end of February. The cost of shipping the container is \$3200, so if you would like to contribute towards getting the items shipped out, the foundation is currently accepting donations.
